This procedural order was issued by presiding judge Thomas as judge-rapporteur, the legally qualified judge Dr Thom and the legally qualified judge Kupecz.

LANGUAGE OF THE PROCEEDINGS: German

SUBJECT: Art. 49(3) UPCA, R. 321 RP - Change of the language of the proceedings

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FACTS:

The plaintiff is bringing an action against the defendant for infringement of the European bundle patent EP 2 697 391 B1 (hereinafter referred to as the patent in suit), which was granted in the English language of the proceedings. It has filed its action in the German language of the proceedings.

In a document dated 23 April 2024 (App_22293/2024), the defendant stated that the parties had agreed to change the language of the proceedings to English. In a document dated 24 April 2024 (App_22330/2024), the plaintiff submitted a comparable pleading and requested a change of language,

pursuant to R. 321.1 RP, English, the language in which patent EP 2 697 391 B1 was granted, to be used as the language of the proceedings.

REASONS FOR THE ORDER:

Pursuant to Art. 49 (3) sentence 1 UPCA, the parties may agree to use the language in which the patent was granted as the language of the proceedings, subject to approval by the competent court. Against this background, a party may submit an application in either language at any time during the written procedure to use the language in which the patent was granted as the language of the proceedings, R. 321.1 RP.

The parties made use of this option in the present case and unanimously declared that they had decided to change the language of the proceedings from German to English. This language change is approved by the adjudicating body, which is why the application for such a language change had to be granted.

ORDER:

The unanimous application of the parties to change the language of the proceedings from German to English is granted.

The proceedings will be conducted in English from the date of this procedural order.
